Reordering update

The congregation of St James were invited to St Mary's on the 25th September in a bid to gauge the feeling of the wider church regarding the proposal put to PCC and unanimously accepted to reorder the current vestries and side chapel. 11 attended and following a discussion about our ministry, and mission, and where we see ourselves, the group were shown how St Mary's had reordered. Following a time of questions the group were asked to vote whether the project should move forward or not. The results of that vote was a majority in favour. (Further details in the October PCC minutes) I have subsequently met with the Archdeacon and have begun the process of obtaining a faculty. This will begin with a site visit to the church by the DAC (Diocesan Advisory Committee) and the archdeacon and I will of course keep you posted at all stages of the process. Please do feel free to chat with me about the project at any time.
