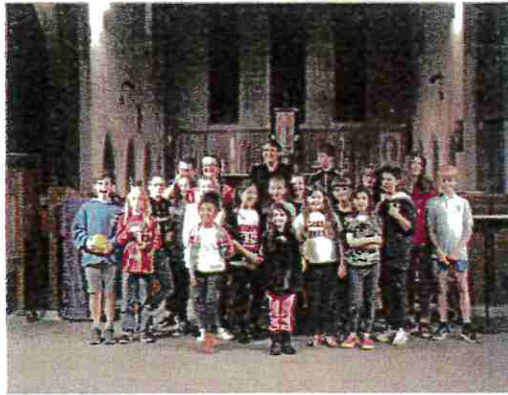

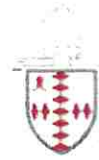

## A Pastoral Letter from Bishop Christopher

As we leave behind the joyful Christmas and Epiphany season we move through the liturgical year and into Lent. Once again, I am pleased to be able to send to you materials for my Lent Call. This year we have taken the theme from Matthew 19.14 "But Jesus said, 'Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of heaven belongs'".

As you and your parish prepare for Lent and begin to look forward to Easter I hope that you will want to pray and reflect upon all that God has done for us in sending his son into our world to bring the Good news. As an aid to this we have included in the pack this year for the first time a booklet with an aid to reflection each day. They have been written by our ordinands and I commend them to you as a helpful way of reflecting up on the projects that we are supporting as well as the Eucharistic passages for each day. 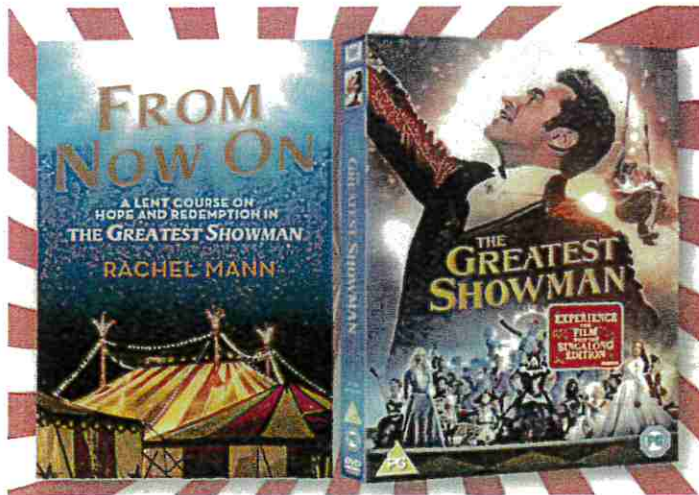

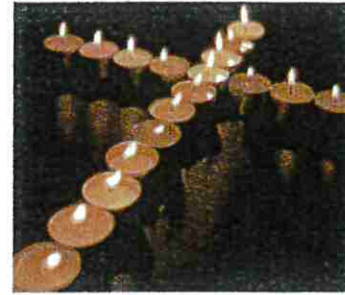
