### Today's said Psalm: 27:4-14

*We respond with the words in bold print*

One thing I ask from the LORD, THIS only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the LORD AND to seek him in his temple.

#### **<sup>5</sup> For in the day of trouble**

**he will keep me safe in his dwelling; he will hide me in the shelter of his sacred tent and set me high upon a rock.**

<sup>6</sup> Then my head will be exalted above the enemies who surround me; at his sacred tent I will sacrifice with shouts of joy; I will sing and make music to the LORD.

**<sup>7</sup> Hear my voice when I call, LORD; be merciful to me and answer me.**

<sup>8</sup> My heart says of you, "Seek his face!" "Your face, LORD, I will seek.

**<sup>9</sup> Do not hide your face from me, do not turn your servant away in anger; you have been my helper. Do not reject me or forsake me, God my Saviour.**

<sup>10</sup> Though my father and mother forsake me, the LORD will receive me.

**<sup>11</sup> Teach me your way, LORD; lead me in a straight path because of my oppressors.**

<sup>12</sup> Do not turn me over to the desire of my foes, for false witnesses rise up against me, spouting malicious accusations.

**<sup>13</sup> I remain confident of this: I will see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.**

<sup>14</sup> Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD.

**<sup>17</sup> May the favour of the Lord our God rest on us; establish the work of our hands for us— yes, establish the work of our hands.**

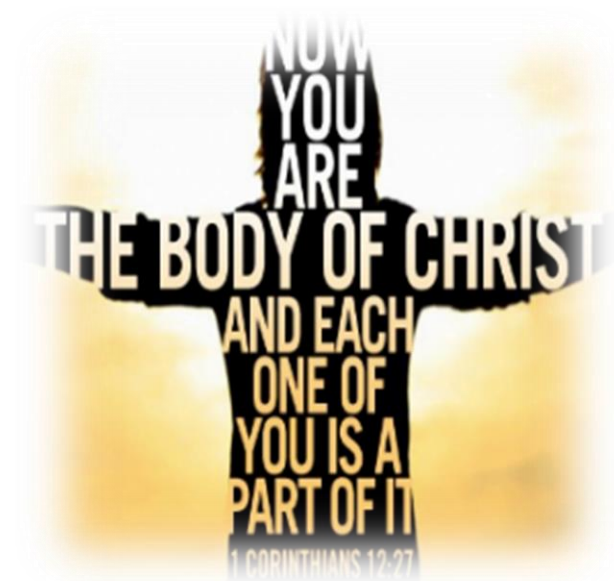
