- 1 Blessed be the Lord the God of Israel,

- 2 **He has raised up for us a mighty Saviour,
born of the house of his servant David.**
- 3 Through his holy prophets God promised of old
to save us from our enemies, from the hands of all
that hate us,
- 4 **To show mercy to our ancestors,
and to remember his holy covenant.**
- 5 This was the oath God swore to our father
Abraham: to set us free from the hands of our
enemies,
- 6 **Free to worship him without fear, holy and
righteous in his sight all the days of our life.**
- 7 And you, child, shall be called the prophet of the
Most High, for you will go before the Lord to prepare
his way,
- 8 **To give his people knowledge of salvation by
the forgiveness of all their sins.**
- 9 In the tender compassion of our God
the dawn from on high shall break upon us,
- 10 **To shine on those who dwell in darkness and
the shadow of death, and to guide our feet into
the way of peace.**
