## Notes for leading PRAYERS:

Please pray as you feel moved, if in doubt please ask Fr. Grant but remember that your role is to help others to pray. To do this, it is best to keep each section short and to the point (5 / 6 sections is enough). Try to connect with a theme from the readings, and the sermon (so contact Fr. Grant in advance to find out the theme of the sermon)

Please use the printed conclusion from the order of service. Please leave a short amount of space and quiet in between the intercessions (before 'Lord in your mercy') A sheet of helpful responses, structure and places to look for inspiration is available should you need it. The Lectionary Year is Year A until we get to Advent Sunday when we begin with year B
