The Kingdom Season (Colour Red)

The four weeks of November represent the end of our annual liturgical pilgrimage. We have journeyed through Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, Lent, Easter, Trinity and Ordinary Time, now we seek out God's kingdom on earth as well as in heaven. We have travelled through the cycle of incarnation and redemption and now we seek the glory of Christ's kingdom. The colour of red is commonly used in church during this month (white for Christ the King)— a colour which reflects both the work of the Holy Spirit and the sacrifice that Jesus made on the cross.

Today's Psalm: 95:1-7 (We respond with the words in bold print)

- ¹Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord; let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation.
- ² Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song.
- ³ For the Lord is the great God, the great King above all gods.
- ⁴ In his hand are the depths of the earth, and the mountain peaks belong to him.
- ⁵ The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land.
- ⁶ Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker;
